Conditions Of Entry

2010

1. The maximum word length is 2,500 words. Due to space limitations, entries over this limit will not be considered.
2. All submissions must be previously unpublished and must not be simultaneously offered to any other publication.
3. For those submissions chosen as finalists, The Adelaide Review reserves first Australian publication rights, both in both printed and electronic formats, for 12 months from the announcement of results. Copyright will remain with the author at all times.
4. All submissions must be written in English.
5. A maximum of one entry per person.
6. Submissions will not be returned.
7. All judging decisions are final and no correspondence will be entered into.
8. Children's fiction is not eligible.
9. Manuscripts must be typed in minimum 12pt font, double spaced and pages numbered. The story title should appear on every page of a submission. The author's name should appear on the cover page only.
10. All submissions must be accompanied by a completed entry form, either downloaded and sent in via post or filled in electronically and sent as an attachment with the submission.

13. All submissions chosen for publication may be edited.
14. One overall winner will be announced and their work will be published in the October 2010 edition of The Adelaide Review and on our website. At the judges' discretion, up to five additional finalists will be selected and their work published on a bi-monthly basis in subsequent editions of The Adelaide Review.
15. The overall winner and finalists will be contacted by telephone or email no later than September 10, 2010.
16. Submissions open May 31, 2010 and close July 23, 2010. Hard copies must be postmarked on or before July 23, 2010 and all electronic submissions must be date stamped at or before midnight CST on July 23, 2010.
17. The Adelaide Review and the Creative Writing Program at the University of Adelaide reserve the right not to award a prize.
18. By submitting work, an author automatically agrees to all the terms and conditions outlined above.
